In 2010, the world's attention was focused on South Africa for two weeks when it hosted the football World Cup. In the city of Durban, where some games were going to be held, a modern new boardwalk* was built as part of a project to clean up the city for the World Cup.

However, there is a dark side to South Africa's World Cup story. In Durban, there are about 400 homeless children who sleep on the streets every night. These children are [37] orphans or have been mistreated* by their parents or relatives. A 14-year-old boy named Wonder is typical of these "street children." After his parents both died, he went to live with his uncle. However, his uncle beat him ([38]) often did not give him any food. Another boy, 9-year-old Khetho, sleeps with his three brothers on the sidewalk. He spends his time [39] begging for money, stealing and sniffing glue* to escape the reality of his sad life.

As part of its effort to clean up the city for the World Cup, Durban regularly rounded up* these street children and took them to a facility 40 kilometers away. The facility, which was meant for adults, seemed more like a jail ([40]) a place for children. Most children escape from the facility and go back to the city. Wonder has been rounded up 15 times, and has returned to Durban every time.

The future does not look bright for Wonder and other homeless children like him. However, a nonprofit community group staffed by former street children called Umthombo is now offering hope for these children in a very unique way. The word *Umthombo* means "spring"* in the native Nguni languages of Southern Africa. There is a particular tree that grows close to springs called the Umthombo tree. In the dry areas of South Africa, an Umthombo tree is a sign of hope.

How is Umthombo trying to help these children? The answer is through surfing.

Umthombo is coaching street kids in surfing to keep them off the street while (41) counseling for their problems. Wonder and Khetho are among a dozen young black boys surfing for hours every day. At the end of the day, he returns his surfboard to a nearby community center, has a meal provided by Umthombo and finds a place to sleep on a downtown sidewalk.

“When I’m surfing, I don’t sniff glue. I want to (42) it behind,” said Wonder. In his tattered wetsuit, he’s found a new identity. After a year of surfing, he won second place in a local competition, getting a trophy, a T-shirt and a big bag of potato chips. Wonder now sees surfing as his way off the streets if he can win more competitions and attract companies to sponsor him. For Wonder and other children like him, Umthombo’s surfing program now offers some hope for a brighter future.
